TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. To advise the Western Australian Genetics Council (WAGC) on the implementation, development, review and modification of prenatal screening programs and diagnostic procedures.
2. To monitor and evaluate prenatal screening programs including the problems and research needs and, where appropriate, advise on standards and monitoring arrangements in Western Australia.
3. To advise the Western Australian Genetics Council (WAGC) on the need for research reviews, for research in relation to prenatal diagnostic procedures and screening and the implementation of research findings.
4. To advise on the continuing education of consumers, GPs and other clinical providers in prenatal screening and diagnosis in Western Australia.
5. To utilise collaborative channels to assess prenatal screening and diagnosis requirements in Western Australia through local and national networks.
